There will be tribulation and distress for every soul of man who does evil . . . all who have sinned without the Law will also perish without the Law . . . in that they show the work of the Law written in their hearts, their conscience bearing witness and their thoughts alternately accusing or else defending them.

Revelation 20:10—And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are also; and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

Ezekiel 28:13-14,18-19—You were in Eden, the garden of God; . . . You were the anointed cherub who covers, And I placed you there. . . . Thou hast defiled thy sanctuaries by the multitude of thine iniquities, by the iniquity of thy traffick; therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of thee, it shall devour thee, and I will bring thee to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold thee. All they that know thee among the people shall be astonished at thee: thou shalt be a terror, and never shalt thou be any more.

NKJ 2 Peter 3:10-13—But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up. . . . All these things will be dissolved. . . . The heavens will be dissolved, being on fire, and the elements will melt with fervent heat. . . . Nevertheless we . . . look for new heavens and a new earth.

Leviticus 10:2-5—And fire came out from the presence of the Lord and consumed them, and they died before the Lord. . . . So they came forward and carried them still in their tunics to the outside of the camp, as Moses had said.

Job 3:20-22—Why is light given to him who suffers, And life to the bitter of soul, who long for death, but there is none, And dig for it more than for hidden treasures, who rejoice greatly, And exult when they find the grave?

Proverbs 8:36—But he who sins against me injures himself; All those who hate me love death.

Romans 2:12—For all who have sinned without the Law will also perish without the Law.

Romans 6:23—For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. (See also John 3:16)

Psalms 145:20—The LORD keeps all who love Him, But all the wicked He will destroy.

Psalms 21:9—You will make them as a fiery oven in the time of your [wrath]; The LORD will swallow them up in His wrath, And fire will devour them.

Obadiah 1:16—They will drink and swallow and become as if they had never existed.

And a poor man named Lazarus was laid at his gate, covered with sores, and longing to be fed with the crumbs which were falling from the rich man's table; besides, even the dogs were coming and licking his sores. Now the poor man died and was carried away by the angels to Abraham's bosom; and the rich man also died and was buried. In Hades he lifted up his eyes, being in torment, and saw Abraham far away and Lazarus in his bosom. And he cried out and said, 'Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus so that he may dip the tip of his finger in water and cool off my tongue, for I am in agony in this flame.' But Abraham said, 'Child, remember that during your life you received your good things, and likewise Lazarus bad things; but now he is being comforted here, and you are in agony. 'And besides all this, between us and you there is a great chasm fixed, so that those who wish to come over from here to you will not be able, and that none may cross over from there to us.' And he said, 'Then I beg you, father, that you send him to my father's house-- for I have five brothers-- in order that he may warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment.' But Abraham said, 'They have Moses and the Prophets; let them hear them.' But he said, 'No, father Abraham, but if someone goes to them from the dead, they will repent!' But he said to him, 'If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be persuaded even if someone rises from the dead.'”

The Bible's Teaching on the Final Fate of the Lost

Ezekiel 33:11—Say to them, 'As I live!' declares the Lord God, 'I take no pleasure in the death of the wicked, but rather that the wicked turn from his way and live. Turn back, turn back from your evil ways! Why then will you die?'

NKJ Luke 9:53-55—But they did not receive Him, because His face was set for the journey to Jerusalem. And when His disciples James and John saw this, they said, 'Lord, do You want us to command fire to come down from heaven and consume them? . . . But He turned and rebuked them, and said, 'You do not know what manner of spirit you are of.'

Matthew 13:36-40—Then He left the crowds and went into the house. And His disciples came to Him and said, "Explain to us the parable of the tares of the field." And He said, "The one who sows the good seed is the Son of Man, and the field is the world; and as for the good seed, these are the sons of the kingdom; and the tares are the sons of the evil one; and the enemy who sowed them is the devil, and the harvest is the end of the age; and the reapers are angels. So just as the tares are gathered up and burned with fire, so shall it be at the end of the age."

Matthew 13:49-50—“So it will be at the end of the age; the angels will come forth and take out the wicked from among the righteous, and will throw them into the furnace of fire; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.”

MRD 2 Peter 2:9—The Lord knoweth how to rescue from afflictions those who fear him; and he will reserve the wicked for the day of judgment to be tormented.

NKJ 2 Timothy 4:1—I charge you therefore before God and the Lord Jesus Christ, who will judge the living and the dead at His appearing and His kingdom.

Revelation 20:11—Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat upon it, from whose presence earth and heaven fled away, and no place was found for them. And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is the book of life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds. And the sea gave up the dead which were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead which were in them; and they were judged, every one of them according to their deeds. Then death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire. And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

John 5:29—And [they] will come forth; those who did the good deeds to a resurrection of life, those who committed the evil deeds to a resurrection of judgment.

Deuteronomy 32:22—For a fire is kindled in My anger, And burns to the lowest part of Sheol, And consumes the earth with its yield, And sets on fire the foundation.

2 Peter 3:7-13—But by His word the present heavens and earth are being reserved for fire, kept for the day of judgment and destruction of ungodly men . . . But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, in which the heavens will pass away with a roar and the elements will be destroyed with intense heat, and the earth and its works will be burned up. But according to His promise we are looking for new heavens and a new earth, in which righteousness dwells.

Psalm 37:20—But the wicked will perish; And the enemies of the LORD will be like the glory of the pastures, They vanish-- like smoke they vanish away.

Psalm 37:10—Yet a little while and the wicked man will be no more; and you will look carefully for his place and he will not be there.

Psalm 68:2—As smoke is driven away, so drive them away; As wax melts before the fire, So let the wicked perish before God.

Psalm 104:35—Let sinners be consumed from the earth and let the wicked be no more.

Malachi 4:1-3—“For behold, the day is coming, burning like a furnace; and all the arrogant and every evildoer will be chaff; and the day that is coming will set them ablaze,” says the LORD of hosts, “so that it will leave them neither root nor branch. But for you who fear My name, the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its wings; and you will go forth and skip about like calves from the stall. You will tread down the wicked, for they will be ashes under the soles of your feet on the day which I am preparing,” says the LORD of hosts.

Revelation 21:4—And He will wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there will no longer be any death; there will no longer be any mourning, or crying, or pain; the first things have passed away.”

Isaiah 66:24—Then they will go forth and look on the corpses of the men who have transgressed against Me.

Song of Solomon 8:6-7—Put me like a seal over your heart, like a seal on your arm. For love is as strong as death. . . . Its flashes are flashes of fire, the very flame of the Lord. Many waters cannot quench love, nor will rivers overflow it.

Romans 12:20—But if your enemy is hungry, feed him, and if he is thirsty, give him a drink; for in so doing you will heap burning coals on his head.

Jeremiah 31:3—I have loved you with an everlasting love.

Matthew 3:7-12—But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees coming for baptism, he said to them . . . ‘Who warned you to flee from the wrath to come. . . . The axe is already laid at the root of the trees; therefore every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. As for me, I baptize you with water for repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I . . . He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. His winnowing fork is in His hand, and He will thoroughly clear His threshing floor; and He will gather His wheat into the barn, but He will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.’

Luke 12:49—I have come to cast fire upon the earth; and how I wish it were already kindled!

NKJ Isaiah 33:10-18—‘Now I will rise,’ says the Lord; ‘Now I will be exalted, now I will lift Myself up. . . . The sinners in Zion are afraid; fearfulness has seized the hypocrites: ‘Who among us shall dwell with the devouring fire? Who among us shall dwell with everlasting burnings?’ He who walks righteously and speaks uprightly, he who despises the gain of oppressions, who gestures with his hands, refusing bribes, who stops his ears from hearing of bloodshed, and shuts his eyes from seeing evil. . . . Your eyes will see the King in His beauty; they will see the land that is very far off. Your heart will meditate on terror.

Revelation 14:9-11—He will be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb. And the smoke of their torment goes up forever and ever; they have no rest day and night.

Isaiah 34:5-10— For My sword is satiated in heaven, Behold it shall descend for judgment upon Edom . . . Its streams will be turned into pitch, And its loose earth into brimstone, And its land will become burning pitch. It will not be quenched night or day; Its smoke will go up forever. From generation to generation it will be desolate; None will pass through it forever

Deuteronomy 28:65-67—Among those nations you shall find no rest, and there will be no resting place for the sole of your foot; but there the Lord will give you a trembling heart, failing of eyes, and despair of soul. So your life shall hang in doubt before you; and you will be in dread night and day, and shall have no assurance of your life. In the morning you shall say, ‘Would that it

2 Chronicles 36:19-21—And they burnt the house of God, and brake down the wall of Jerusalem, and burnt all the palaces thereof with fire, and destroyed all the goodly vessels thereof. Mark 16:20—And they went out and preached everywhere, while the Lord worked with them, and confirmed the word by the signs that followed. [And they promptly reported all these instructions to Peter and his companions. And after that, Jesus Himself sent out through them from east to west the sacred and imperishable proclamation of **eternal salvation**.
